


A quick guide to interpreting your smoke results

No evidence of smoke exposure


If all dots are on the line or within the grey bars.



Uncertain evidence of smoke exposure


If some dots are just above the line and some dots within the grey bars.



Exposure detected

Contact AWRI helpdesk

If all dots are above the grey bars.



Grey bars = natural baseline (variety specific)



Red dots = your sample result



Dashed line = upper limit of baseline range

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
