Wine show judging – an insider's view

The Australian Wine Research Institute's one-day course provides an insider's view of judging on the Australian national wine show circuit. Three highly respected wine show chairs each with different approaches to judging will take you onto their panels as associate judges. Each panel will consist of just four associate judges and one panel chair.

Over the day you will taste various brackets of wines – all selected from a recent Australia national wine show. Tasting through each bracket, you will then work directly with the panel and your panel chair to discuss each wine and reach a consensus panel score – just as you would in a wine show.

Attendees will spend time with each of the three panel chairs, experiencing their different judging styles and tips.

This is a unique opportunity to hone your wine judging skills under Australian wine show conditions, with guidance from some of Australia's top wine show chairs.

The Australian Wine Research Institute (AWRI) is the Australian grape and wine industry's own research organisation. The AWRI has been training wine show judges through the internationally respected Advanced Wine Assessment Course since 1992. Over 1,100 participants have graduated from this program.
