Non-chemical weed control

Chris Penfold will provide an overview of a range of options for non-chemical weed control and the advantages, disadvantages, and considerations of each option. Robyn Dixon will present a non-chemical weed control case study from your region and will also provide a brief update on the AWRI non-chemical weed control tool.

Cover crops

Prof. Tim Cavagnaro, Dr Thomas Lines or Joe Marks from the University of Adelaide will present the results of their cover crop trials in the Barossa and Langhorne Creek and discuss the impact of undervine cover crops on vine and yield measurements and fruit composition. Matt Holdstock will present a tasting of the wines produced from the Barossa Valley cover crop trial and will discuss the impact of cover crops on wine quality parameters.
